

Anti-DDX 18 antibody, rabbit serum

DDX18 protein (670aa, 75.4KDa) is a putative ATP-dependent RNA helicase since it possesses a DEAD box motif, characterized by the conserved motif, Asp-Glu-Ala-Asp (DEAD). RNA helicases which may play a role in ribosome biogenesis. DDX18 acts as a cofactor for XPO1-mediated nuclear export of incompletely spliced HIV-1 Rev RNAs. It was also involved in HIV-1 replication and interacts specifically with hepatitis C virus core protein resulting in a change in intracellular location.

Applications

1) Western blotting (1000~ 2,000 fold dilution) 2) Immunofluorescence staining (~500 fold dilution)

Not tested for other applications

Reactivity: Reacts with DDX18 of human and rodents.

Immunogen: Purified Human DDX18 fused with GST

Form: Undiluted anti rabbit serum added with 0.05 % sodium azide

Storage: Shipped at 4°C or -20°C and stored at -20°C.




Fig.1 Western blot analysis of DDX18 in the whole cell extracts of HeLa cells (10 μ g) with anti-DDX18 antibody at 1,000 fold dilution
