The **U**biquitin **c**arboxyl-terminal **h**ydrolase isozyme **L1** (**UCHL 1**) enzyme is a member of a protein family involved in the hydrolyzation of C-terminal adducts of polymeric ubiquitin to generate monomeric ubiquitin. It is abundantly expressed in neurons throughout the brain and belongs to the ubiquitin-proteasome system. This pathway is responsible for the degradation of misfolded and damaged proteins and has been postulated to play an important role in Parkinson's disease.
